

## The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

What will you need:

**RENEWALS FOR THE NEW YEAR: BEGINNING JANUARY 1<sup>st</sup>** . Anyone using the food pantry must provide documentation for **each** member of the household.

Acceptable documents included (but not limited to):

Wisconsin Immunization Registry Records (Recent)

Report Cards (Recent)

Birth Or Baptismal Certificates

Passport

Medical, Insurance or Library Cards

Driver's Licenses

State/Military/Tribal Ids

First-Class Mail Postmarked Within the Past 30 Days

**No** Social Security Cards

Applicants **must** also provide documentation of current address. One of the following is acceptable; the pantry may accept others:

- **First-class mail postmarked within the past 30 days**
- Rent or mortgage receipt
- A rent or lease agreement or property tax bill

ALSO: please stop using the food pantry if you no longer qualify.

**At each visit after application:**

1. Bring your ID
2. **Tell us if your address or household size has changed.** You must bring documentation for these changes
